

Rules for Student Award of Center of Medical Education in English for Scientific Achievements

The Award aims to honour the scientific activity of CMEE students who publish articles in peer-reviewed journals, participate in research grants, and present communications during scientific meetings.

All scientific activities must be affiliated with Poznan University of Medical Sciences.

1. The Student Award is an annual individual or team monetary award conferred through competition for outstanding, precisely defined and confirmed published articles in peer-review journals, research grants, and communications during the student's study period at PUMS.
2. The Student Award is granted in three categories (I°, II°, III°) according to the JCR Impact Factor of journals and Ministry of Education scores, the role of the student in the research grant, a form of scientific communication (i.e. oral or poster, during local or international conferences). If students apply for a team award, it is necessary to assess each student's involvement in the project (expressed with %).
3. Attachments must prove all scientific activities: pdf of the full version of the published article, certificate of communication during a scientific meeting, and confirmation of participation in research grant signed by the principal investigator/grant holder.
4. The Award may be received only once for each scientific activity (article, communication, grant).
5. Each scientific activity submitted for the competition must be affiliated with Poznan University of Medical Sciences in Poznań, Poland.
6. The Prize is awarded by the CMEE Dean Council, which serves as the jury for the competition.
7. The selection procedure for Award candidates starts with an application- sent via email to Mr Tomasz Gołembski at tgolembki@ump.edu.pl.

8. The condition for receiving the prize is to have a PESEL number.
9. The number and amount of prizes depend on the budget and the final decision of the PUMS Rector.
